Llamas

Artwork celebrating llamas and the people of the Andes.

Up to 30 artworks available. This exhibit can be made with either/or two and three dimensional artwork. This exhibition includes a slide show and a crossword puzzle. (optional)

Ages: Elementary ages

Recommended Workshop: Family Stories – Illustrating Your Story. Explore diverse family traditions and create personalized illustrated stories that capture your favorite memories.

El Brindis

Historic and contemporary photography documenting the evolution of alcoholic beverages in Mexico.

Up to 90 framed photographs available. This exhibit is two dimensional artworks only.

Ages: This exhibit is customized for either all ages or adult.

Recommended Workshop: Frida Kahlo – Queen of the Selfie. Discover how Frida used art as a powerful tool for self expression and create a mixed-media “selfie” collage that reflects your unique identity and perspective.





Hilos

Garments and textiles as well as artwork and illustrations depicting various traditional clothing made and worn in communities throughout Latin America.

Textiles can be displayed hanging or on a bust. Up to 50 two and three dimensional artworks available.

Ages: All ages

Recommended Workshop: Posada Printmaking – The Art of Protest. Create your own protest print addressing a cause you care about, inspired by Jose Guadalupe Posada’s use of printmaking as a tool of resistance.

Rhythm & Dance

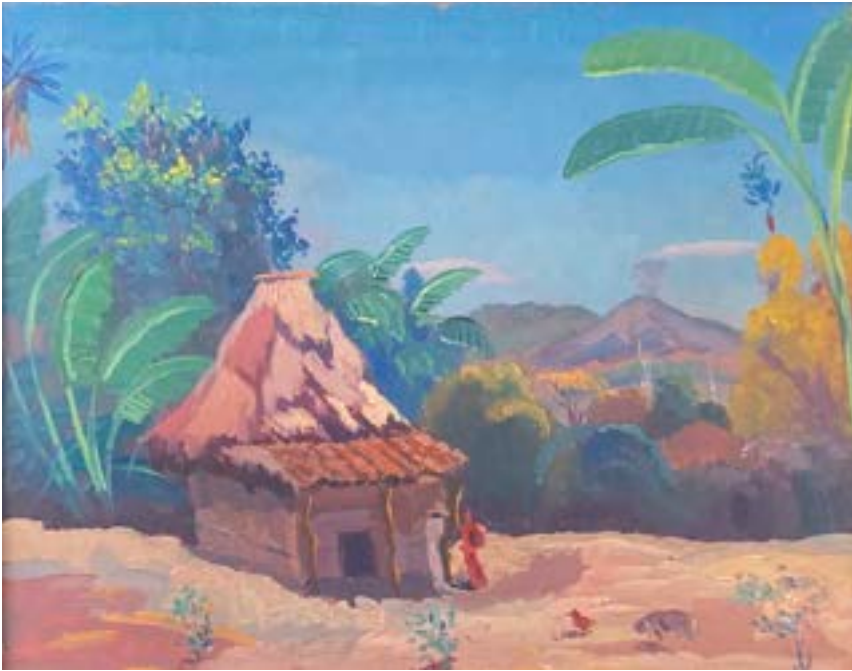
Masks, musical instruments, artwork and artifacts exploring the rich history and contemporary practices of music and dance.

Up to 40 two and three dimensional artworks available.

Ages: All ages

Recommended Workshop: Guatemalan Textiles – Weaving Identity and Place. Learn about weaving techniques and make your own textile while discovering the connection between textiles, identity, and history in Guatemala.





El Paisaje

A collection of prints and paintings of landscapes and pastoral scenes. The exhibit elaborates on each region's flora and fauna as well as architectural and geographic features.

Up to 30 artworks available. This exhibit can be made with either/or two and three dimensional artwork.

Ages: All ages

Recommended Workshop: Vejigante – Masks of Puerto Rico
Learn about the history of Puerto Rico and how a devilishly and wild masked creature, the Vejigante, found its way into Puerto Rican festivities.

Retablos

A selection of the Peruvian retablos in Museum's collection. These shadow boxes open to a three dimensional tableau of religious imagery or scenes of daily life such as markets, shops, harvests, weddings and other ceremonies.

Up to 15 Peruvian retablos. This exhibit is three dimensional artworks only

Ages: All ages

Recommended Workshop: "El Movimiento" – The Chicano Movement in Denver. Explore the inspiring Chicano Movement and its impact on Denver. Learn how young people can create positive change through art and activism.





Locals

Artwork by Latinx/Chicanx artists living and working along the front range.

Up to 15 artworks available. This exhibit can be made with either/or two and three dimensional artwork.

Ages: All ages

Recommended Workshop: “El Movimiento” The Chicano Movement in Denver.

Oaxaca

A series of artistic photographs which capture the ambiance of Oaxaca, Mexico and the surrounding area.

Up to 20 framed photographs. This exhibit is two dimensional artworks only.

Ages: All ages

Recommended Workshop: Día de los Muertos – Guiding Lights Using Brown Dog Gadgets materials, students learn to create a circuit to brighten up their Dia de los Muertos creations with LED lights.





Día de los Muertos

Artwork and objects relating to the history and meaning of Día de los Muertos.

Up to 20 artworks available. This exhibit is primarily three dimensional pieces with one accompanying large framed print (optional).

Ages: All ages

Recommended Workshops: Día de los Muertos, A Living Tradition or Día de los Muertos or, Guiding Lights or Posada Printmaking - The Art of Protest.

Resistance and Historical Memory in Guatemala

A series of photographs by documentarian and human rights advocate Jonathan Moller. The exhibit documents indigenous communities in Guatemala as they exhume, identify and perform burial rites for their loved ones who were murdered and placed in clandestine graves by the military during Guatemala's civil war.

Up to 20 framed photographs available. This exhibit is two dimensional artworks only.

Ages: Teen/adult

Recommended Workshops: Self guided reflection worksheet.





La Niñez

Toys, miniatures, objects and artwork celebrating children at work and play throughout Latin America.

Up to 40 two and three dimensional artworks available.

Ages: All ages

Recommended Workshops: Family Stories-Illustrating Your Story.

Lámina

A collection of Mexican Láminas, which are religious paintings on tin that use iconography and symbolism to convey meaning.

Up to 30 artworks. This exhibit is two dimensional artwork only.

Ages: All ages

Recommended Workshops: Mexican Tin Workshop.





Horsepower

A selection of artwork which tells the story of the Columbian Exchange focusing on horses arriving in the Americas.

Up to 20 two and three dimensional artworks available.

Ages: This exhibit is customized for either all ages or adult.

Recommended Workshops: Guiding Lights.

De la tierra

Artwork and objects depicting the traditional foods of Latin America as well as the history and impact of agriculture.

Up to 40 two and three dimensional artworks available.

Ages: All ages

Recommended Workshops: Family Stories-Illustrating Your Story or Three Sisters.





Meaning of Molas

A celebration of the craftsmanship and meaning of molas made by the indigenous communities of Panama.

Up to 30 framed molas. This exhibit is two dimensional artwork only.

Cara a Cara

An exhibit featuring Museo's large mask collection, which explores the power and mystery of masks as an essential piece of ceremonial traditions.

Up to 100 masks as well two and three dimensional artworks available.

Rebeldes

A collection of artwork and artifacts reflecting on the stories of the rebels and revolutionaries of Latin America.

Up to 20 two and three dimensional artworks available.
